Interning students will be exposed to challenging, professional opportunities while working in the offices of leading architectural, interior, and landscape design firms, assisting with documentation of historic properties, and participating in urban planning and design, as well as a variety of other related projects. A \$1000 stipend will be included with the internship and housing provided.

Grade point average greater than 3.0

Commitment to the program beginning on June 10 through July 19, 2019

Stipend of \$1000, housing provided
