2023 Summer Intern project

The summer project will be a collaborative research project focused on one of the projects designed by John L. Volk in the Bahamas in 1952. The Volk collection is housed at the Preservation Foundation and physical and digital drawings may be referenced.

- Examine 230 drawings pertaining to the development of Andros Island by architect John L. Volk
- Rename digital files in accordance with their project number and drawing number
- Create a narrative and select images and drawings that best illustrate the story of the project
- Contextualize the narrative with information about Andros Island and Bahamian history

Deliverables:

- Create an online exhibition about the Andros Island project
- Develop an outline that may be used for a publication that features this project
- Increase the scholarship of the collection by documenting the project
- Highlight architectural features of the project, many of which Volk also utilized in South Florida
