The Preservation Foundation of Palm Beach is looking for graduate and undergraduate students enrolled in a degree-seeking program in archival studies, library and information science, or historic preservation to participate in a six-week program this summer from **June 15 to July 24, 2021**.

The Foundation is a private, nonprofit membership organization dedicated to the preservation of the historic, architectural, and cultural heritage of Palm Beach, Florida. The Foundation's mission is to encourage the community to learn about and save the historic buildings that truly make Palm Beach special.

Interns will be exposed to challenging, professional opportunities while working with the digital collection of the Preservation Foundation of Palm Beach. The collection includes digital records of architectural drawings, photographs, and ephemera from prominent Palm Beach architects. Experience with image/photo editing in Adobe Creative suite and Microsoft Word and Excel is required.

A \$1000 stipend will be included with the internship.

- Two (2) original letters of recommendation from any two of the following: Graduate department chair, professor, academic advisor, former/current work supervisor.
- Resume
- Digital portfolio or writing sample (research paper, 15-20 pages)

Personal Statement (no more than 500 words) answering the following questions:

1. Why would you like to intern at the Preservation Foundation of Palm Beach?
2. How does the Foundation's internship fit with your background and career goals?
3. What do you hope to achieve from the experience and what do you believe you can contribute?
