The Preservation Foundation of Palm Beach is looking for graduate and undergraduate students enrolled in a degree-seeking program in Public History, Library and Information Science, or Historic Preservation to participate in a six-week program this summer. The program runs from the first week of June until the second week of July.

Interns will be exposed to challenging, professional opportunities while working with the Preservation Foundation of Palm Beach's collections. The collections include paper and digital records of architectural drawings, photographs, and ephemera from prominent Palm Beach architects. Experience with Microsoft Word and Excel is required.





 - What do you hope to achieve from the experience and what do you believe you can contribute to the Foundation?
